

The third mohair sale of the 2025 summer season was exceptionally large. To help alleviate some of the downward pressure on prices caused by the size of the offering, HF had to withdraw 18 tons of hair from the bins. The exchange rate also did not help, as the Rand strengthened by 2% to 3% against the US dollar. Given these factors, the fact that the market decreased by only 1% should be considered acceptable for producers. The next sale is also expected to be noticeably large. On the positive side, this indicates that production and quality continue to rise, good news for overseas manufacturers. A good example of this quality improvement is the best bale of summer kids from Sarel and Matthys du Plessis of Oudtshoorn. Fetching R740.00 per kilogram, it achieved the highest price of the sale, but its statistics are even more impressive. It was a super-style bale, full B-length, testing at 22.2 microns, with a clean yield of 96%! This bale was purchased by an Italian spinner for a special project. The next sale is scheduled for the 15th of April 2025 and will be held at the International Mohair Exchange.
