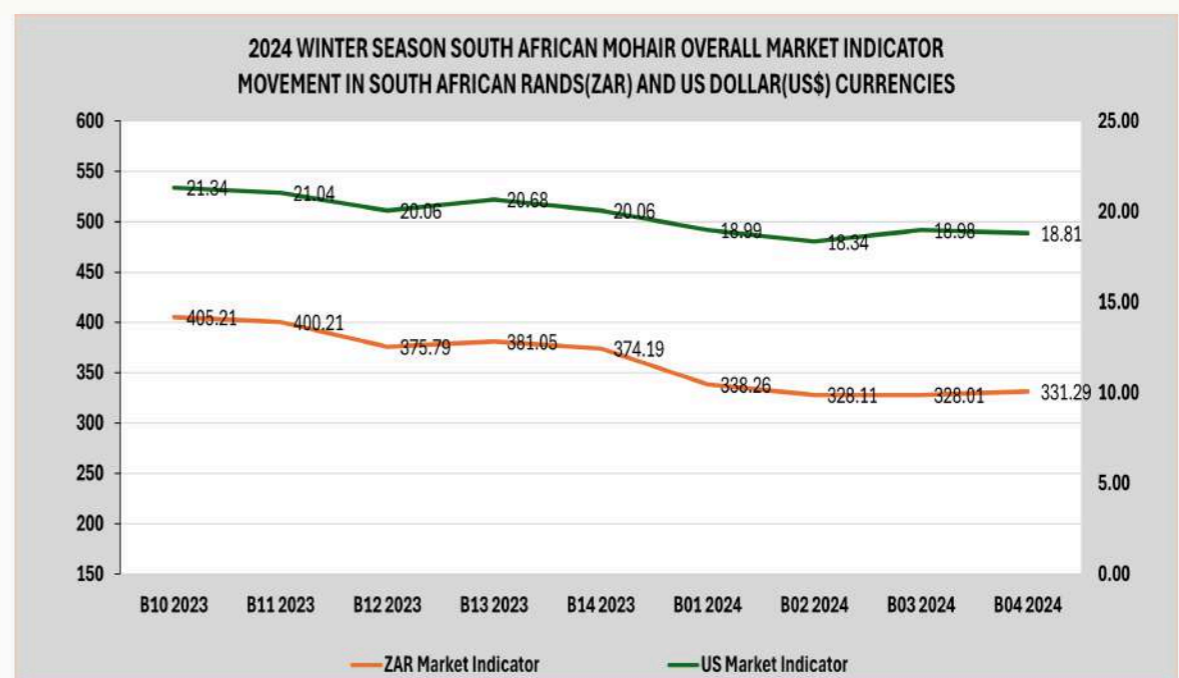

The 4th mohair sale of the 2024 winter selling season had satisfactory results. Although there was no major price movement, the price movement there was, was better. This signals the turning point in this season's prices and demand. However, it is still a worrying situation with just the two processing buyers that took up 90% of the market. We need all six buying houses to compete. The 26-micron to 28-micron performed very well, but the 29-micron to 31-micron is still neglected with prices down. The Rand was 1% weaker than the US Dollar and the market increased by 1%. However, the sale's highlight was the two top winter kid bales of Daan and Phillip Schutte from De Rust and Martin Koorts from Prince Albert. The Schutte bale was a super style, 24-micron bale with a clean yield of 89.1% and sold for a seasonal record price of R900.00/kg! The Koorts bale was also a super style bale, testing 26 microns with a clean yield of 90.4% and sold for R800.00/kg! This winter kid bales would have been good competition for the top bales of the summer season! The next sale will be a little bigger, but with excellent quality on offer and will held on the 5th of November 2024.
