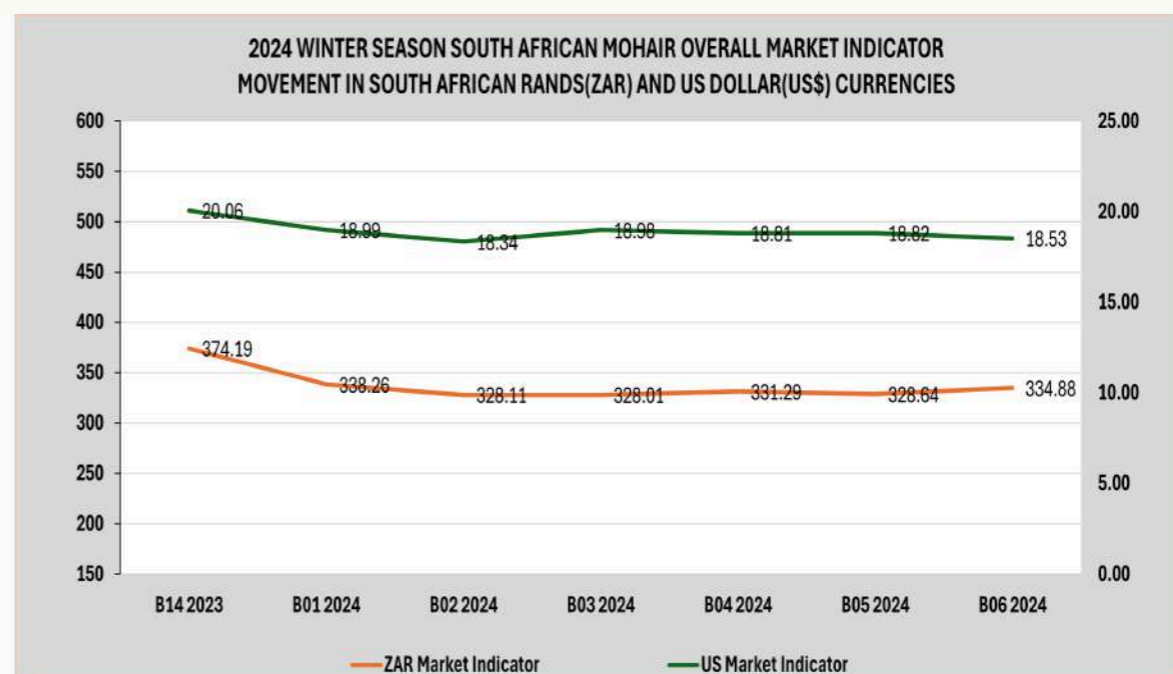

The second-to-last sale (the sixth) of the 2024 winter selling season consistently produces satisfactory results due to a wide selection of high-quality clips on offer. This sale did not disappoint. The only negative factor was the downward pressure on the fine kids with 3% on average and a lot of these types of bales were not sold. Ninety-three percent of the offering was RMS certified with a positive price margin of 18%. Although the exchange rate was exactly 1.9% in the seller's favour, HF does not think it played any significant role. The superior quality on offer made the difference. The limelight was stolen by the eye-catching 27-micron winter kid bale of Michau Nortje of Willowmore. This super style, B-length mohair had a clean yield factor of 96% and sold at a record price for a twenty-seven-micron bale at R741.00/kg. The second highest price went to Van Hasselt Farming for his 26-micron winter kid bale at R725.00/kg. This Van Hasselt clip maintains his record as the best clip in the world! It won the international MIYUKI award for the best clip for ten years in a row! The next sale will be smaller, and the last sale of the year will take place on the 3rd of December 2024 in the Mohair Exchange.
