Comment

The last mohair sale for the 2022 summer selling season delivered a mixed bag of results again. There were excellent bales on offer, and the best price of R880.00/kg went to Schalk and Andreas Nel from Steytlerville. This 22.5-micron bale, with a clean yield of 88.8% and super style, B-length summer kid mohair deservedly fetched the third best price of the season. With not all buyers competing on the same level as the previous sale, there was downward price pressure on the stronger half of the catalogue. The official results do not reflect this because the brokers kept back lots that dropped in price by more than 5%. The vast gap between RMS certified mohair and non-certified mohair kept growing with a difference of more than R30.00/kg, like on the previous sale. House of Fibre and BKB clients must please remember that the warehouse will move to Grahamstown Road in Deal Party and will start to weight-in on the new, state of the art premises from the 1st of July 2022.
