



Dear mohair producers,

We find increasingly that farmers put the small bags (split lots) in the same container with mohair despatched for sorting. This means that the whole container will be sorted, and the sorting tariff charged on the total weight. That is an unnecessary cost for the farmer. Please keep the small bags that is already sorted separate and put in one container (bag/bale) and mark as BIN. All mohair meant to be sorted in a separate container (bag/bale) marked for as SORT.
